A formal intake is required

Applications will be accepted on a first come, first served basis; priority will be given to first-time campers and children who have not previously received services at the Children's Bereavement Center of South Texas (CBCST). Please note that submitting information on this Initial Camp Inquiry does not guarantee a spot at Camp Heroes. Before we can enroll your child/children in camp services, you will need to complete the following:

- Phone Intake Appointment: Intake staff will collect detailed demographic information (including custody documentation) over the phone.
- Phone Biopsychosocial Assessment: A therapist will gather information about your child/children, including any traumatic experiences, mental health history, medical information, behavioral concerns, and accommodations.
- If risk-related concerns are identified during this assessment, we will request an inperson assessment at CBCST prior to making any recommendation on services.
