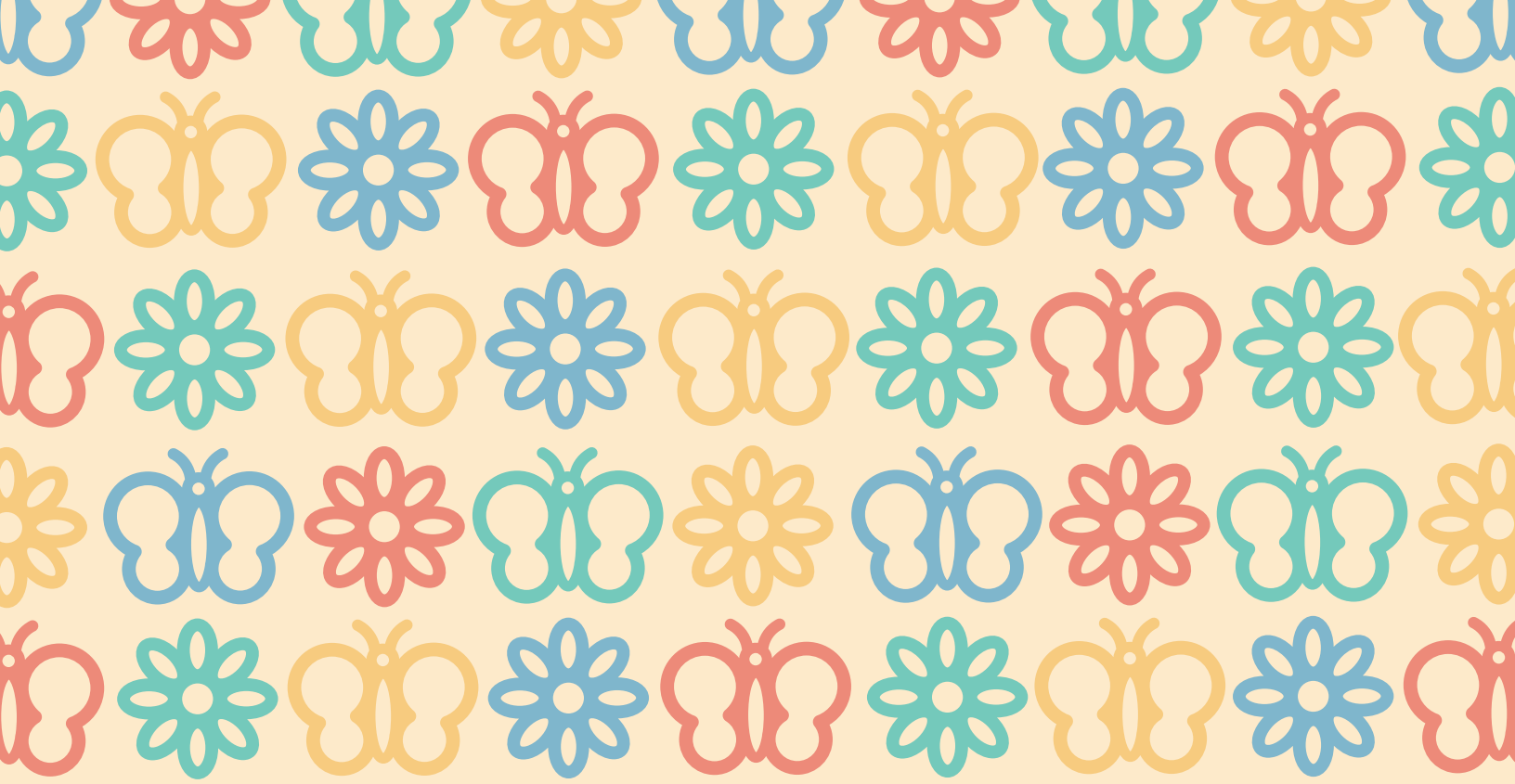
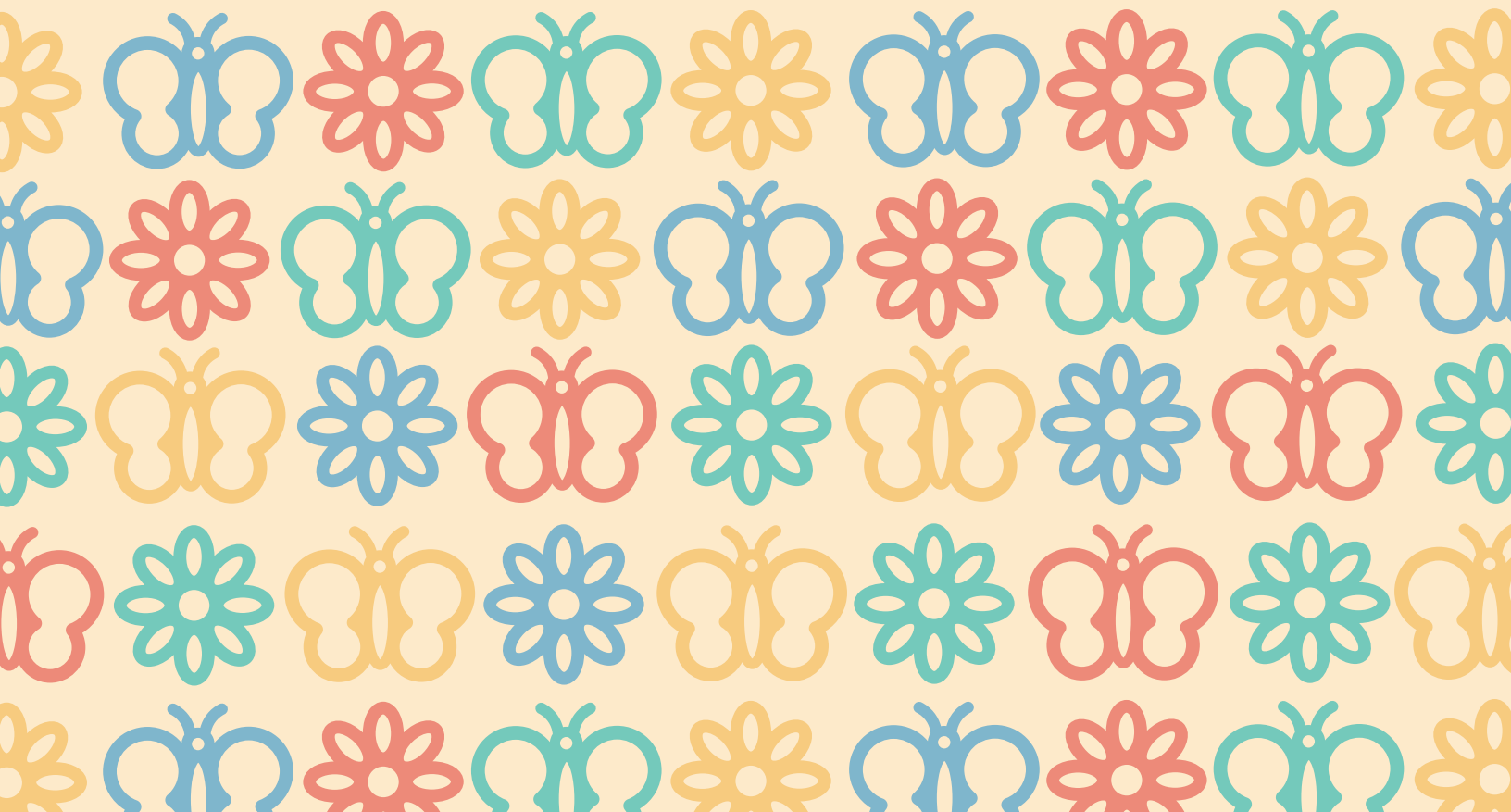

Whether they join us for individual counseling, peer-led support groups, grief camps or a healing circle during a time of heavy emotions, our families are welcomed into the Center with open arms. The Center provided over 8,400 hours of individual counseling across South Texas – **ALL AT NO COST TO OUR FAMILIES.** Every child's grief experience is unique and will impact them differently at every stage of life. The Center's specialized grief counseling is critical for ensuring healthy development and bright futures. Meeting with each child one-on-one allows us to identify their needs and develop individualized plans for coping and emotional regulation. These are skills our children and caregivers can take with them beyond their time at the Center, fostering hope and healing for years to come.



PEER SUPPORT *Groups*

The Center opens its doors to families four nights a week for peer-led support groups. These groups do so much more than offer families a safe space to share their grief – they create community. Our support groups allow children and families to connect with those who understand their journey. We offer Little Hearts, a specialty group for the unique needs of 3-6 year olds as they are still developing the language to express their new and heavy emotions. Their experiences build support systems to lean on in the difficult months and years to come.

When facing the heavy loss of a parent, classmate or other loved one, school can become a difficult space for grieving children. Heavy emotions and major disruptions in routine can create challenges in the classroom. By placing counseling staff in school districts across South Texas, we are able to meet children right where they are, and right when they need it. Removing barriers to care and taking a community-centered approach to grief counseling makes all the difference for our families.

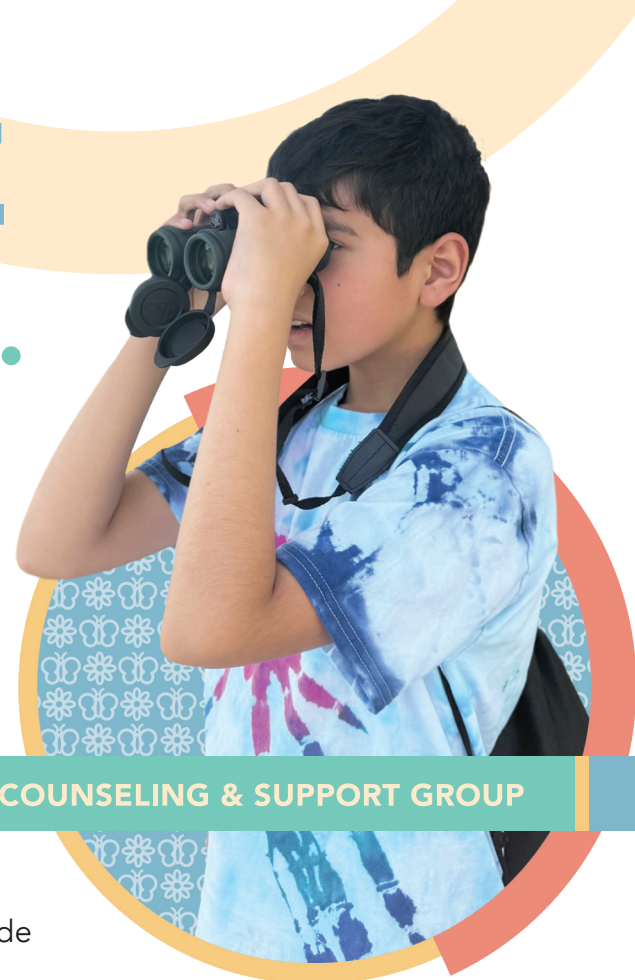

HILL COUNTRY INDIVIDUALS SERVED

The July 4th flooding across the Hill Country will have a tremendous, long-lasting impact on our community. The grief felt by those who lost loved ones, their homes, and so much security is monumental.

With the support of incredible partners in the Hill Country including St. Peter's Episcopal Church, Hill Country CASA and the Hunt School, the Center was able to establish a safe space for families affected by the flooding. In the days and weeks following the floods, our counselors held healing circles and offered consultations to families navigating their difficult next steps. As these needs grow, we will continue to provide trauma-informed grief counseling across the Hill Country.

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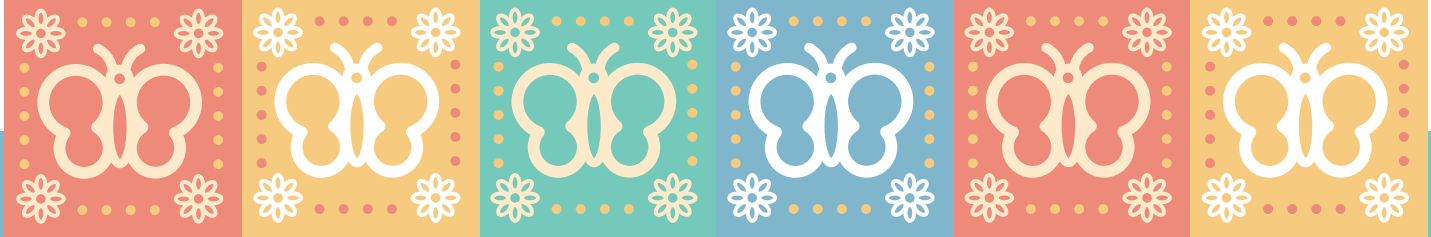
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
